Met-Ed has contracted Treesmiths, Inc. to perform their tree and vegetation management along their overhead distribution electric facilities and equipment. The purpose of this program is to maintain safe and reliable electric service.

Met Ed performs this maintenance on a four-year cycle. It includes tree pruning and hazard tree removal. Trees are pruned to provide a minimum of four years of clearance. The clearance varies, depending on the tree species; however, clearance is generally twelve to fifteen feet from the electric wires. Trees that are dead and/or endanger Met-Ed facilities, as well as those trees that cannot be pruned due to their position to the wires are removed.

Met Ed encourages their contractors to work with the developments, to utilize the best practical methods to carry out this work. Branches that result from this pruning will be chipped and removed from site. Any hazard tree needing to be removed will have the wood cut to handling length and will remain on site. Wood chips are available to the community, or individual property owners by request, free of charge.
